### **Creative School (2019-2022. Closed Project)**

The EU 2020 Strategy acknowledges that education and training can help tackle key challenges Europe currently is facing. In this regard, the Creative School project aimed to deliver creative and critical-thinking educational approaches to schools in partnership with museums, science centres and galleries. It gathered 9 European partners - cultural organisations, associations, libraries and networks - to work on open educational resources and recommendations.

Open-access educational materials focusing on the enhancement of creative and critical thinking as well as a set of recommendations are available on the project's website.

## The GLAMers (2021-2023. Closed project)

The GLAMers project reflected how it is possible to **further youth engagement in GLAMs** (Galleries, Libraries, Archives and Museums) in Europe, especially during the COVID-19 crisis.


To do so, the project:

- provided an open-access collection of good practices involving youth engagement as a means of GLAM recovery during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- offered an open-access online MOOC, providing advice and training opportunities to support GLAMs in their digital transformation through the participation of youth
- allowed GLAMs to implement and then assessed the digitally-enhanced activities involving youth.

All the resources are now available on the website: a study on existing initiatives, an online MOOC for GLAMs, a collection of good practices of applying the project resources and much more.
