

Call: Connecting Europe Facility – Telecommunications 2014 - Europeana - Core Service Platform

# **Objective**

DSIs are composed of 'core service platforms' which enable trans-European connectivity and interoperability, and related 'generic services' which link national and sectorial infrastructures to the platforms. Under funding from the Connecting Europe Facility, Europeana will develop into a widely recognised platform of services and resources, not only for metadata references, but also for access to cultural content, tools and technologies, projects and other services.
