European Union Prize for Cultural Heritage/ Europa Nostra Awards 2018

In total 29 winners from 17 countries were selected from 160 applications, submitted by organisations and individuals from 31 countries across Europe. The prize goes to projects in Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Netherlands, Portugal, Serbia, Slovenia and Spain. On May 22, the European Commission adopted a **New Agenda for Culture** which will be instrumental in raising awareness of Europe's shared, diverse heritage. It aims to use the full potential of culture in building a more inclusive and fairer European

Union, supporting innovation, creativity, s ustainable jobs and growth and in reinforcing the external relations of the EU.

The Agenda aims to contribute to the legacy of the EYCH and announced an Action Plan for Cultural Heritage including & Digital4Culture strategy. The Agenda is based on quite the same structure than the previous one, with 2 new cross cutting issues: Cultural Heritage & Digital.

On 30th May, the European Commission presented their proposal for the Creative Europe programme 2021-2027. Michael Culture welcomes continuity and increased budget (by Euro 390 million) of the programme as a promising development strongly promoted by CAE and its members including Michael Culture.

Key elements: increased opportunities for cross-border cooperation and cross-border projects, **mobility for artists and cultural and creative operators** and a **broader approach to the digital transformation** that affects the cultural and creative sectors.

CEF Telecom - Europeana: €3.8 million EU investment (CEF-TC-2017-3): 8 proposals will be granted €3.8 million with applicants from 18 EU Member States to enhance accessibility of digital resources of European heritage.

MCA will lead the dissemination activities of the **CrowdHeritage project**, which is focusing on the development of a crowdsourcing platform for the validation of metadata enrichments. In the project, coordinated by the National Technical University of Athens, are involved also the Europeana Fashion International Association and the French Ministry of Culture.
