The aggregators


Europeana works with three types of aggregator:

MUSEU is the aggregator for the museums.





Europeana Data Exchange Agreement - Annex 1: COD 1.0 Universal Public Domain Dedication



Data Exchange Agreement

- All metadata submitted to Europeana will be published as open data under the terms of the Creative Commons Zero Public Domain Dedication (CC0).
- Each digital object (which includes the associated preview) that is available via Europeana needs to carry a rights statement that describes its copyright status. If an object is in the public domain, it must be labelled as being in the public domain.





The aggregation workflow

6 steps

- 1. Make your digitized cultural Heritage objects and metadata available online
- 2. Import your metadata in MINT
- 3. Map to LIDO using MINT
- 4. Make a successful transformation to LIDO
- 5. Preview your records
- 6. Publish to the MINT OAI server

Det flikiga bladet i skiftande kulörer för tanken till växtfärgämnen som krapp, gulreseda och indigo. Teheran ritades i början av 1940-talet men trycktes inte förrän 1991 för första gången.











Michael Culture 3 — Map to LIDO using MINT






